Each law enforcement agency or other employing agency whose officers are required to meet the training requirements of subsection (1)(j) of Section 3 of this Act, or whose officers voluntarily meet the requirements of subsection (1)(b) of Section 2 of this Act, shall retain a record of each of its officers having met the biennial training. These records shall be made available upon request to the Kentucky Law Enforcement Council and to the Justice and Public Safety Cabinet."
