Beginning on page 4, line 23, by deleting Section 2 and renumbering subsequent sections;

On page 7, by deleting lines 10 and 11 and inserting the following in lieu thereof:

"duration~~[, of which the number of hours shall not be changed by the council]~~, at";

On page 7, line 12, after "council" by inserting "**, which may include a four (4) hour course which meets the requirements of paragraph (j) of this subsection**";

On page 8, line 6, bracket and strikethrough "and";

On page 9, line 4, before the period, by inserting:

; **and**

(j) Requires all police officers to successfully complete by December 31, 2022, and every two (2) years thereafter a training course, certified by the council, of not less than four (4) hours in emergency vehicle operation";

On page 10, line 14, after "**degree**", by inserting "**when the offense involved the operation of a motor vehicle**";

On page 12, by deleting Section 5 of the bill; and

On page 13, after line 4, by inserting:

"→SECTION 4. A NEW SECTION OF KRS CHAPTER 15 IS CREATED TO READ AS FOLLOWS:
