3	Be i	t enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:
4		→SECTION 1. A NEW SECTION OF KRS CHAPTER 64 IS CREATED TO
5	REA	AD AS FOLLOWS:
6	<u>(1)</u>	As used in this section, "elected official" means the county judge/executive,
7		<u>county clerk, county attorney, sheriff, jailer, coroner, surveyor, property</u>
8		valuation administrator, justice of the peace, magistrate, county commissioner,
9		and constable.
10	<u>(2)</u>	When the amount of a fee is established in the Kentucky Revised Statutes for
11		services provided by an elected official, the amount of the fee stated in the statute
12		shall be considered the maximum fee amount, and the elected official may charge
13		a lower fee amount with approval of the fiscal court when it has been determined
14		that the maximum fee amount is not needed to perform the service or to meet the
15		budgetary needs of the elected official's public office or the county.
16	<u>(3)</u>	If an elected official charges a lower fee amount:
17		(a) The elected official shall post a schedule of the effective fee rates:
18		1. On the official Web site for the elected official's public office, if a Web
19		site is maintained; and
20		2. In a conspicuous area of the elected official's public office for the
21		public to view;
22		(b) The elected official shall maintain for audit purposes a historical record of
23		the fee rates, which shall include the effective date of any fee that is lowered
24		pursuant to this section; and
25		(c) The lower fee amount will be the prevailing fee amount that is applicable to
26		all citizens within the elected official's jurisdiction.
27	(4)	(a) This section only applies to fees that are charged by the elected official and

1		collected for the use of performing the service or funding the elected
2		official's public office or the county.
3	<u>(b)</u>	Neither the elected official nor the fiscal court shall have the authority to
4		reduce the revenues to be generated on behalf of the Commonwealth or any
5		other entity.
