On page 3, between lines 19 and 20, insert the following:

**"If the annual audit determines that the city or county has spent the revenues received from the imposition of the regulatory license fee in a manner inconsistent with this section, the city or county shall provide a refund of the amount improperly spent to all payors of the regulatory license fee in an amount equal to their prorated portion of the revenues collected by the city or county that are directly attributable to the improper spending."**

On page 3, line 22, before "Provide", insert the following:

**"For a first offense,"**

On page 3, line 25, after "July 15, 2014" insert the following:

**", and be responsible for the payment of the reasonable attorney fees directly incurred by a party to the litigation, in an amount ordered by the court upon its finding of an intentional and willful violation of this section by a city or county occurring after July 15, 2014"**

On page 3, line 26, after "(b)", insert the following:

**"For a second offense within a period of five (5) years, provide a refund and be responsible for the payment of attorney fees pursuant to paragraph (a) of this**
