4		→SECTION 1. A NEW SECTION OF KRS CHAPTER 158 IS CREATED TO
5	REA	D AS FOLLOWS:
6	<u>(1)</u>	To assist public schools in meeting the needs of students and implementing KRS
7		158.4416, each local school district shall utilize a mental health screening as
8		needed for determining the behavioral health status of students.
9	<u>(2)</u>	Beginning with the 2020-2021 school year, each school district shall contract
10		with a student mental health screening provider to furnish a comprehensive
11		behavioral health tool designed to help identify and prioritize needed services and
12		supports for students. Each school district shall select a screening that is time
13		efficient and cost effective and will help schools identify at-risk students,
14		determine appropriate interventions, and provide ongoing monitoring.
15	<u>(3)</u>	Funds appropriated by the General Assembly to the Kentucky Department of
16		Education for the purposes of this section shall be distributed annually to each
17		school district for the cost of the mental health screening contract, except that the
18		department shall determine a maximum disbursement amount based on the
19		number of students in a district and the current market rate for student mental
20		health screenings.
21	<u>(4)</u>	School mental health screenings shall be administered in accordance with 20
22		U.S.C. sec. 1232h, including requiring prior written consent of the parent or the
23		student if he or she is at least eighteen (18) years old or legally emancipated.
24		→ Section 2. There is hereby appropriated to the Kentucky Department of
25	Educ	cation from the General Fund \$4,000,000 in each fiscal year of the 2020-2022 fiscal
26	biennium for the procurement of student mental health screenings by local school	
27	districts.
