15			regarding the health of the animal and the need for veterinary treatment, and		
16			the client, whether owner or other caretaker, has agreed to follow the		
17			instructions of the veterinarian;		
18		(b)	There is sufficient knowledge of the animal by the veterinarian to initiate at		
19			least a general or preliminary diagnosis of the medical condition of the animal.		
20			This means that the veterinarian has recently seen and is personally acquainted		
21			with the keeping and care of the animal by virtue of an examination of the		
22			animal or by medically appropriate and timely visits to the premises where the		
23			animal is kept; and		
24		(c)	The practicing veterinarian is readily available or shall provide medical		
25			service for follow-up in case of adverse reactions or failure of the regimen of		
26			therapy. A new regimen of therapy shall be contingent only upon cooperation
