

1 AN ACT relating to exemptions from fees for operator's licenses and personal  
2 identification cards.

3 ***Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:***

4 ➔Section 1. KRS 186.531 is amended to read as follows:

5 (1) As used in this section:

6 (a) "AOC Fund" means the circuit court clerk salary account created in KRS  
7 27A.052;

8 (b) "GF" means the general fund;

9 (c) "IP" means instruction permit;

10 (d) "License Fund" means the KYTC photo license account created in KRS  
11 174.056;

12 (e) "MC" means motorcycle;

13 (f) "MC Fund" means the motorcycle safety education program fund established  
14 in KRS 15A.358;

15 (g) "OL" means operator's license; and

16 (h) "PIDC" means personal identification card.

17 (2) The fees imposed for voluntary travel ID operator's licenses, instruction permits,  
18 and personal identification cards shall be as follows. The fees received shall be  
19 distributed as shown in the table. The fees shown, unless otherwise noted, are for an  
20 eight (8) year period:

19 (4) The fee for a second or subsequent duplicate personal identification card for a  
20 person who does not have a fixed, permanent address, as allowed under KRS  
21 186.4122(5) and 186.4123(5), shall be the same as for a duplicate regular personal  
22 identification card.

23 (5) The fee for a four (4) year original or renewal license issued pursuant to KRS  
24 186.4101 shall be fifty percent (50%) of the amount shown in subsections (2) and  
25 (3) of this section. The distribution of fees shown in subsections (2) and (3) of this  
26 section shall also be reduced by fifty percent (50%) for licenses that are issued for  
27 four (4) years.

- 1 (6) Any fee for any identity document applied for using alternative technology under  
2 KRS 186.410 and 186.4122 shall be distributed in the same manner as a document  
3 applied for with the circuit clerk.
- 4 (7) (a) An applicant for an original or renewal operator's license, commercial driver's  
5 license, motorcycle operator's license, or personal identification card shall be  
6 requested by the clerk to make a donation to promote an organ donor program.
- 7 (b) A donation under this subsection shall be two dollars (\$2) for any license or  
8 card with an eight (8) year term, and one dollar (\$1) for any license or card  
9 with a term of less than eight (8) years.
- 10 (c) The donation under this subsection shall be added to the regular fee for an  
11 original or renewal motor vehicle operator's license, commercial driver's  
12 license, motorcycle operator's license, or personal identification card. One (1)  
13 donation may be made per issuance or renewal of a license or any  
14 combination thereof.
- 15 (d) The fee shall be paid to the circuit clerk and shall be forwarded by the clerk on  
16 a monthly basis to the Kentucky Circuit Court Clerks' Trust for Life, and such  
17 moneys are hereby appropriated to be used exclusively for the purpose of  
18 promoting an organ donor program. A donation under this subsection shall be  
19 voluntary and may be refused by the applicant at the time of issuance or  
20 renewal.
- 21 (8) In addition to the fees outlined in this section, the following individuals, upon  
22 application for an initial or renewal operator's license, instruction permit, or  
23 personal identification card, shall pay an additional application fee of thirty dollars  
24 (\$30), which shall be deposited in the road fund:
- 25 (a) An applicant who is not a United States citizen or permanent resident and who  
26 applies under KRS 186.4121 or 186.4123; or
- 27 (b) An applicant who is applying for a instruction permit, operator's license, or

1 personal identification card without a photo under KRS 186.4102(9).

2 **(9) A veteran who served in the Armed Forces of the United States, including the**  
3 **Coast Guard, National Guard, or Reserve component, shall not be subject to the**  
4 **fee for a voluntary travel ID operator's license, a standard operator's license, a**  
5 **motorcycle operator's license, an instruction permit, or a personal identification**  
6 **card if the veteran:**

7 **(a) Is disabled with a service-connected disability evaluation of fifty percent**  
8 **(50%) or higher;**

9 **(b) Completed his or her term of service and was released, separated, or retired**  
10 **under either an honorable discharge or a general under honorable**  
11 **conditions discharge; and**

12 **(c) Is not subject to sex offender registration requirements.**

13 **(10) In order to receive the fee exemption under this section a veteran shall provide:**

14 **(a) A signed letter on disability status issued by the United States Department of**  
15 **Veterans Affairs;**

16 **(b) A Defense Department Form 214 (DD 214); or**

17 **(c) A National Guard Bureau Form 22.**
