2	2 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:		
3		→Section 1. KRS 257.210 is amended to read as follows:	
4	(1)	The board shall appoint the state veterinarian.	
5	(2)	The state veterinarian shall be a [resident of this state and a]licensed [graduate	
6			
7		at least five (5) years prior to his or her appointment.	
8	(3)	The state veterinarian shall serve for a term of four (4) years and until \underline{a} [his]	
9		successor has been appointed [and has qualified].	
10	(4)	He <u>or she</u> shall be subject to removal from office by the board at any time for cause.	
11	(5)	The office of the state veterinarian shall be in the Department of Agriculture[at the	
12		state capital].	
13		Section 2. KRS 257.240 is amended to read as follows:	
14	(1)	Upon the recommendation of the state veterinarian, the board may within its	
15		discretion appoint a deputy state veterinarian.	
16	(2)	<u>The deputy state veterinarian</u> [He] shall hold office for a term of four (4) years and	
17		until \underline{a} [his] successor has been elected and qualified. He $\underline{or she}$ shall be subject to	
18		removal from office by the board at any time for cause.	
19	(3)	The deputy state veterinarian [He] shall be a [resident of this state, and a]licensed	
20		[graduate]veterinarian who has practiced veterinary medicine [continuously within	
21		this state] for <u>at least[a period of]</u> three (3) years prior to his <u>or her</u> appointment.	
22		\Rightarrow Section 3. Whereas the board faces time-sensitive personnel issues relating to	
23	the deputy state veterinarian position, an emergency is declared to exist, and this Act		
24	take	s effect upon its passage and approval by the Governor or upon it otherwise becoming	
25	law.
