4	The Kentucky	Law Enforcement Council is hereby established as an independent

24	and	Western Districts of Kentucky may confer and designate a local law

4		privileges. Each ex officio member may designate in writing a person to
5		represent him or her and to vote on his or her behalf. Designees of the
6		Department of Kentucky State Police, Department of Criminal Justice
7		Training, Louisville Metro Police Department, and the Lexington-Fayette
8		Urban County Division of Police shall be the head of the agency's training
9		division or the agency's deputy chief or deputy commissioner.
10	<u>(b)</u> [(2)] Twelve (12) members shall be appointed by the Governor for terms of
11		four (4) years from the following classifications:
12	<u>1.</u>	A city manager or mayor: [,]
13	<u>2.</u>	A county judge/executive; [,]
14	<u>3.</u>	Three (3) Kentucky sheriffs: [,]
15	<u>4.</u>	A member of the Kentucky State Bar Association; [,]

18		No person shall serve beyond the time he or she holds the office or
19		employment by reason of which he or she was initially eligible for
20		appointment. Vacancies shall be filled in the same manner as the original
21		appointment and the successor shall be appointed for the unexpired term. Any
22		member may be appointed for additional terms.
23	<u>(2)[(3)]</u>	No member may serve on the council with the dual membership as the
24	representative of more than one (1) of the aforementioned groups or the holder of	
25	more than one (1) of the aforementioned positions. In the event that an existing	
26	member of the council assumes a position entitling him to serve on the council in	
27	another capacity, the Governor shall appoint an additional member from the group	

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- 1 concerned to prevent dual membership.
- 2 (3)[(4)] Membership on the council does not constitute a public office, and no member
- 3 shall be disqualified from holding public office by reason of his membership.
- 4 → Section 2. KRS 15.320 is amended to read as follows:
- 5 The business of the council shall be conducted in the following manner:
- 6 (1) The council at its initial meeting to be held promptly after the appointment of its
- 7 members, shall elect a chairman and vice chairman from among its members who
- 8 shall serve until the first meeting in the succeeding year. Thereafter, the chairman
- 9 and vice chairman shall be elected at the first meeting of each calendar year.
- 10 (2) <u>Thirteen (13)</u>[Ten (10)] members of the council shall constitute a quorum for the
- 11 transaction of business.
- 12 (3) The council shall maintain minutes of its meetings and such other records as it
- deems necessary.
- 14 (4) The council shall report at least annually to the Governor and to the General
- 15 Assembly as to its activities.

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
