13	amount appro	priated by the General Assembly is less than the amount
14	necessary to n	neet the requirements of this paragraph, the salary supplement
15	received by ea	ch qualified speech language pathologist or audiologist shall be
16	reduced propo	rtionately by the Department of Education so that all eligible

15	(3) The supplement authorized by this section shall be considered in the calculation for		
16	contribution to the Kentucky Teachers' Retirement System.		

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
