## **UNOFFICIAL COPY**

1	AN ACT relating to Medicare supplement insurance.
2	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:
3	→ Section 1. KRS 304.14-520 is amended to read as follows:
4	Notwithstanding any other provision of state law of this state, for a Medicare
5	supplement policy available, issued, or renewed in this state on or after the effective
6	date of this Act:
7	(1) An insurer shall not deny, or condition the issuance or effectiveness of, the
8	policy, nor discriminate in the pricing of the policy, based on the age, gender,
9	health status, claims experience, receipt of health care, or medical condition of
10	an applicant or a person covered under the policy; [may not deny a claim for losses
11	incurred more than six (6) months from the effective date of coverage for a pre-
12	existing condition. The policy may not define a pre-existing condition more
13	restrictively than a condition for which medical advice was given or treatment was
14	recommended by or received from a physician within six (6) months before the
15	effective date of coverage.]
16	(2) The policy shall not contain any waiting period or pre-existing condition
17	limitation or exclusion; and
18	(3) Applications shall be accepted, and policies shall be issued, at all times
19	throughout the year.
