

1 AN ACT relating to cannabidiol products.

2 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:*

3 ➔SECTION 1. A NEW SECTION OF KRS 217.005 TO 217.215 IS CREATED
4 TO READ AS FOLLOWS:

5 (1) As used in this section:

6 (a) "Cannabidiol" means a non-psychoactive cannabinoid found in the hemp
7 plant *Cannabis sativa* which consists of a chemical compound containing
8 twenty-one (21) carbon atoms, thirty (30) hydrogen atoms, and two (2)
9 oxygen atoms;

10 (b) "Certificate of analysis" means a document produced by a laboratory that
11 has been accredited pursuant to standard of the International Organization
12 for Standardization, attesting to the composition of a product. The
13 certificate of analysis shall include but not be limited to the amount of
14 delta-9 tetrahydrocannabinol, the amount of other cannabinoids, the
15 amount of pesticide residues, the amount of heavy metal traces, the amount
16 of mycotoxin contaminants, the amount of residual solvents, and the
17 amount of microbiological contaminants;

18 (c) "Hemp" has the same meaning as in KRS 260.850; and

19 (d) "Quick response code" or "QR code" means a type of machine-readable,
20 two (2) dimensional bar code that stores information about a product.

21 (2) The cabinet shall promulgate administrative regulations to establish labeling
22 requirements for ingestible or cosmetic cannabidiol products in accordance with
23 the provisions of this section.

24 (3) Ingestible or cosmetic cannabidiol products shall bear labeling to allow the
25 consumer to access information on the product, including the certificate of
26 analysis for the product, the location where the hemp was grown, and the address
27 and phone number of the manufacturer or distributor using the following:

- 1 (a) A scannable bar code, including the batch number or serial number of the
2 product;
- 3 (b) A QR code; or
- 4 (c) A Web address linked to a document or Web site.
- 5 (4) No product labeling or advertising material for any ingestible or cosmetic
6 cannabidiol product sold or otherwise distributed in the Commonwealth shall
7 bear any claims stating that the product can diagnose, treat, cure, or prevent any
8 disease.
- 9 (5) A manufacturer or processor of ingestible or cosmetic cannabidiol products
10 located in Kentucky shall be permitted as a food manufacturer or a cosmetic
11 manufacturer by the cabinet and shall provide the following information:
- 12 (a) The name of the manufacturer or processor and the physical address where
13 production or processing occurs; and
- 14 (b) A listing of the cannabidiol products to be produced or processed.
