

1 AN ACT relating to assisted-living communities.

2 ***Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:***

3 ➔Section 1. KRS 194A.705 is amended to read as follows:

- 4 (1) The assisted-living community shall provide each client with access to the
5 following services according to the lease agreement:
- 6 (a) Assistance with activities of ***his or her*** daily living and instrumental activities
7 of daily living;
 - 8 (b) Three (3) meals and snacks made available each day;
 - 9 (c) Scheduled daily social activities that address the general preferences of
10 clients; and
 - 11 (d) Assistance with ***his or her*** self-administration of medication.
- 12 (2) Clients of an assisted-living community may arrange for additional services under
13 direct contract or arrangement with an outside agent, professional, provider, or other
14 individual designated by the client if permitted by the policies of the assisted-living
15 community.
- 16 (3) Upon entering into a lease agreement, an assisted-living community shall inform the
17 client in writing about policies relating to the contracting or arranging for additional
18 services.
- 19 (4) A client issued a move-out notice shall receive the notice in writing and the
20 assisted-living community shall assist each client upon a move-out notice to find
21 appropriate living arrangements. Each assisted-living community shall share
22 information provided from the department regarding options for alternative living
23 arrangements at the time a move-out notice is given to the client.
- 24 (5) An assisted-living community shall complete and provide to the client:
- 25 (a) Upon move-in, a copy of a functional needs assessment pertaining to the
26 client's ability to perform activities of daily living and instrumental activities
27 of daily living; and

- 1 (b) After move-in, a copy of an updated functional needs assessment pertaining to
- 2 the client's ability to perform activities of daily living and instrumental
- 3 activities of daily living.
