- 23 (3) Encourages the Social Security Administration to augment its current efforts to
- 24 disseminate information to the public about the Ticket to Work program;
- 25 (4) Requests the United States Congress undertake comprehensive reform of the Social
- 26 Security Disability programs to better distinguish between fraudulent and legitimate
- claims and to facilitate return to work options for those who wish and are able to do
