

1 A JOINT RESOLUTION designating the Oscar Green Memorial Highway in
2 Magoffin County.

3 WHEREAS, Oscar Green was born March 1, 1922, in the Seitz community in
4 Magoffin County, Kentucky, and left these earthly bounds on October 15, 2008; and

5 WHEREAS, Oscar Green enlisted in the United States Army on January 26, 1943,
6 and served until his honorable discharge on October 4, 1948; and

7 WHEREAS, Oscar Green proudly served in the Third Army, 80th Infantry Division,
8 seeing action in some of the most important battles in World War II, including the
9 Normandy Invasion and the Battle of the Bulge; and

10 WHEREAS, Oscar Green was injured on three separate occasions during his
11 service, and was honored with several commendations, including the Bronze Star Medal,
12 Purple Heart, and Silver Star; and

13 WHEREAS, Oscar Green returned to Salyersville after his military service and
14 married his precious wife Dollie, to whom he was married for 62 years in a union that
15 was blessed with seven children; and

16 WHEREAS, Oscar Green served as an example for family and friends throughout
17 his life, as evidenced by his acceptance of Jesus Christ as his personal Savior through his
18 baptism on October 27, 1956, as well as his tireless work ethic as a member of the
19 Plumbers and Pipefitters Local Union 248; and

20 WHEREAS, Oscar Green's life of service to his faith, family, and country is
21 deserving of tangible recognition;

22 NOW, THEREFORE,

23 ***Be it resolved by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:***

24 ➔Section 1. The Transportation Cabinet shall designate Kentucky Route 3337 in
25 Magoffin County as the "Oscar Green Memorial Highway" and shall, within 30 days of
26 the effective date of this Resolution, erect appropriate signage denoting this designation.
