

1 A JOINT RESOLUTION directing the Transportation Cabinet to erect signs in
2 Garrard County that proclaims the city of Lancaster as the Home of the Kentucky Motion
3 Picture and Television Hall of Fame.

4 WHEREAS, the Kentucky Motion Picture Hall of Fame is partnered with the
5 Lancaster Grand Theater as its new permanent home; and

6 WHEREAS, the Kentucky Motion Picture Hall of Fame has been created to bring
7 attention to the many successes of Kentucky's many actors and filmmakers; and

8 WHEREAS, the Motion Picture Hall of Fame Class of 2020 will be the inaugural
9 class of inductees; and

10 WHEREAS, Jim Varney, Chase Dudley, Lee Majors, Vin Morreale Jr., and Conrad
11 Bachmann will be the first to receive this great honor as the members of the 2020 Class
12 of inductees; and

13 WHEREAS, Jim Varney got his start acting on the stage at Lafayette High School
14 in Lexington, and later became an Emmy winning actor most known for his role as Ernest
15 P. Worrell in all of the "Ernest" films; and

16 WHEREAS, Chase Dudley is an independent filmmaker based out of Louisville
17 most known for his films "Past Due" and "Marvelous Mandy"; and

18 WHEREAS, Lee Majors is a Middlesboro native who honed his acting skills at the
19 Pioneer Playhouse in Danville. He is most known for his role as Colonel Steve Austin in
20 "The Six Million Dollar Man"; and

21 WHEREAS, Vin Morrelae Jr. is an accomplished actor, director, producer,
22 playwright, songwriter, teacher, author, and casting agent who is helping prepare
23 Kentucky's next generation of entertainers; and

24 WHEREAS, Conrad Bachmann served eight years as the Governor of the
25 Performers Peer Group for the Academy of Television Arts & Sciences and has appeared
26 in television shows such as Matlock, Starsky and Hutch, and Little House on the Prairie
27 through the decades; and

1 WHEREAS, The Kentucky Motion Picture Hall of Fame stands as a symbol for
2 Kentucky's aspiring entertainers to pursue their dreams as many Kentuckians have before
3 them;

4 NOW, THEREFORE,

5 *Be it resolved by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:*

6 ➔Section 1. The Transportation Cabinet is directed to honor the Kentucky Motion
7 Picture and Television Hall of Fame by erecting signs on United States Highway 27 and
8 Kentucky Route 52 at the Lancaster city limits in Garrard County that reads, "Home of
9 the Kentucky Motion Picture Hall of Fame." The signs shall be erected within 30 days of
10 the effective date of this Resolution and shall remain in place for at least one year from
11 the date of its placement.
