

1 A JOINT RESOLUTION designating a section of Kentucky Route 44 in Bullitt
2 County in honor and memory of Lieutenant Scotty McGaha.

3 WHEREAS, Lieutenant Scotty McGaha was born on June 30, 1950, in Louisville,
4 Kentucky; and

5 WHEREAS, Lieutenant Scotty McGaha was the son of Maeola and James Clifford
6 McGaha; and

7 WHEREAS, Lieutenant Scotty McGaha was a United States Marine Corps veteran
8 who served from 1968 to 1970 during the Vietnam War; and

9 WHEREAS, Scotty McGaha served his community for nearly four decades as a
10 Lieutenant in the Bullitt County Sheriff's Office; and

11 WHEREAS, Lieutenant Scotty McGaha passed from this life on January 18, 2020,
12 joining his wife of 49 years, JoAnn, who died four months earlier; and

13 WHEREAS, Lieutenant Scotty McGaha is survived by his children Telly, James,
14 and Casye, his mother Maeola, two siblings, and his three grandchildren Anthony,
15 Sydney, and Noah; and

16 WHEREAS, the Scotty and JoAnn McGaha Scholarship in Criminal Justice has
17 been established at the University of Louisville to be offered to first-generation college
18 students and to veterans allowing Scotty and JoAnn's positive impact to be felt for years
19 to come; and

20 WHEREAS, this highway designation will serve as a constant reminder of
21 Lieutenant Scotty McGaha's life and commitment to serving those in Bullitt County;

22 NOW, THEREFORE,

23 ***Be it resolved by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:***

24 ➔Section 1. The Transportation Cabinet shall designate Kentucky Route 44 from
25 mile marker 12.574 to mile marker 13.309 in Bullitt County and erect signs that read:

26 "Lieutenant Scotty McGaha

27 Bullitt County Deputy Sheriff
