

1 A RESOLUTION commending Taiwan for its relations with the United States.

2 WHEREAS, Taiwan and the United States are longstanding allies who both deeply
3 cherish the common values of freedom, democracy, human rights, and the rule of law;
4 and

5 WHEREAS, in the year 2020, Taiwan held its seventh direct presidential election
6 and once again demonstrated the strength and vitality of its robust democratic system,
7 paving the way for Taiwan as a beacon for democracy in Asia and beyond. This body
8 congratulates Dr. Tsai Ing-wen on her re-election as the 15th President of Taiwan, and
9 along with her Vice President Lai Ching-te, she hopes to build the country's already rich
10 tradition of economic vitality, cultural growth, and innovation; and

11 WHEREAS, Taiwan serves the best interests of the Asia-Pacific region in the
12 continuation of stability and growth; and

13 WHEREAS, since 1982, the Commonwealth of Kentucky and Taiwan have enjoyed
14 long, cordial, and mutually beneficial sister-state relations, a friendship that continues to
15 strengthen with each passing year. By working together with Taiwan, Kentucky welcomes
16 all opportunities for an even closer economic and higher educational partnership; and

17 WHEREAS, Taiwan is the United States' ninth-largest trading partner, and the
18 United States is Taiwan's second-largest trading partner; in 2018, Kentucky's exports to
19 Taiwan reached \$177.6 million. Taiwan is Kentucky's seventh largest export market in
20 Asia; and

21 WHEREAS, the Republic of China (Taiwan) Agricultural and Trade Mission of
22 2015 signed memorandums of understanding with Kentucky to purchase soybeans and
23 corn in 2016 and 2017; and

24 WHEREAS, the Taiwan Travel Act is an act of the United States Congress, passed
25 on February 28, 2018 and signed into law on March 16, 2018, and conceived as a follow
26 up to the Taiwan Relations Act which was signed on April 10, 1978, to encourage visits
27 between the United States and Taiwan at all levels; and

1 WHEREAS, the designation of Taiwan into the United States' Visa Waiver
2 Program is a significant step to draw travelers from Taiwan choosing the United States as
3 their destination for trade, investment, and sightseeing; the MOU of Reciprocal Driver's
4 License also benefits relations between Taiwan and Kentucky; and

5 WHEREAS, Taiwan is an active member in the international community with a
6 long history of commitment to international health and humanitarian aid as well as
7 environmental protection. This body congratulates Taiwan on its democratization efforts
8 and meaningful participation in many international organizations;

9 NOW, THEREFORE,

10 ***Be it resolved by the House of Representatives of the General Assembly of the***
11 ***Commonwealth of Kentucky:***

12 ➔Section 1. The members of the House of Representatives commend and support
13 the democratization efforts of Taiwan and the nation's meaningful participation in the
14 World Health Organization, the International Civil Aviation Organization, and the UN
15 Framework Convention on Climate Change, as well as other international organizations
16 such as the International Criminal Police Organization, and extend their most sincere best
17 wishes for continued cooperation and success.
