1	A RESOLUTION urging the Kentucky Department of Education to create a task
2	force to consider ways to improve diversity in STEAM areas of education.
3	WHEREAS, literacy in science, technology, engineering, the arts, and mathematics
4	(STEAM) is critical to the progress and prosperity of our great Commonwealth and
5	Nation; and
6	WHEREAS, strong STEAM education is essential to preparing Kentucky students
7	for the future of labor and industry in this competitive, global economy; and
8	WHEREAS, research supports that children who are highly engaged in the arts
9	perform better academically, are more engaged in school, achieve higher levels of
10	postsecondary education, and are more engaged in positive civic pursuits beyond their
11	school years; and
12	WHEREAS, inclusive access to STEAM education will better equip our students,
13	the future workforce of this Commonwealth, to approach complex problems in STEAM
14	areas from more diverse and creative perspectives; and
15	WHEREAS, an emphasis on reaching out to students of color, low-income students,
16	female students, and other student groups underrepresented in the different STEAM areas
17	to encourage interest and participation is vital to meeting our workforce needs; and
18	WHEREAS, the Kentucky Department of Education is the state agency best suited
19	for assessing the diverse obstacles faced by schools across the Commonwealth, including
20	rural and urban schools, in the promotion of STEAM education; and
21	WHEREAS, the Kentucky Department of Education is also in a prime position to
22	ensure that teachers across the Commonwealth are equipped with high-quality STEAM
23	educational resources and information; and
24	WHEREAS, the General Assembly previously expressed a commitment to STEAM
25	education in the Commonwealth in enacting KRS 158.645 and KRS 158.845 to 158.849;
26	NOW, THEREFORE,
27	Be it resolved by the House of Representatives of the General Assembly of the

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1 Commonwealth of Kentucky:

2 →Section 1. The House of Representatives urges the Kentucky Department of
3 Education to establish a task force to consider ways to improve diversity in different
4 fields of STEAM education in Kentucky, with an emphasis on increasing the participation
5 of student groups traditionally underrepresented in each of the STEAM fields, including
6 but not limited to students of color, low-income students, and female students.
