KRS 95.022 is amended to read as follows: 4 (1) As used in this section: 5 "City" means any incorporated city, consolidated local government, unified 6 local government, urban-county government, or charter county government, 7 operating under the law of this Commonwealth, and the offices and agencies 8 thereof; and 9 "Police officer" has the same meaning as "police officer" in KRS 15.420 and as "officer" in KRS 16.010. 10 11 (2) Subject to the limitations of subsection (7) of this section, a city may employ 12 individuals as police officers under this section who have retired from the Kentucky 13 Employees Retirement System, the County Employees Retirement System, or the 14 State Police Retirement System. 15 To be eligible for employment under this section, an individual shall have: (3) 16 (a) Participated in the Law Enforcement Foundation Program fund under KRS 17 15.410 to 15.510 or retired as a commissioned officer pursuant to KRS 18 Chapter 16; 19 (b) Retired with at least twenty (20) years of service credit; 20 (c) Been separated from service for the period required by KRS 61.637 so that the 21 member's retirement is not voided; 22 (d) Retired with no administrative charges pending; and 23 Retired with no preexisting agreement between the individual and the city (e) 24 prior to the individual's retirement for the individual to return to work for the 25 city.

26 (4) Individuals employed under this section shall:

27 (a) Serve for a term not to exceed one (1) year. The one (1) year employment term

1		may be renewed annually at the discretion of the employing city;		
2		(b) Receive compensation according to the standard procedures applicable to the		
3		employing city; and		
4		(c) Be employed based upon need as determined by the employing city.		
5	(5)	Notwithstanding any provisions of KRS 16.505 to 16.652, 18A.225 to 18A.2287,		
6		61.510 to 61.705, or 78.510 to 78.852 to the contrary:		
7		(a) Individuals employed under this section shall continue to receive all		
8		retirement and health insurance benefits to which they were entitled upon		
9		retiring in the applicable system administered by Kentucky Retirement		
10		Systems;		
11		(b) Individuals employed under this section shall not be eligible to receive health		
12		insurance coverage through the employing city;		
13		(c) The city shall not pay any employer contributions or retiree health expense		
14		reimbursements to the Kentucky Retirement Systems required by KRS

16		(d) The city shall not pay any insurance contributions to the state health insurance

20		service, or other legislative due process provisions applicable to the employing city.

23	(7)	A city government shall be limited in the number of retired police officers that it		
24		may hire under this section as follows:		
25		(a) A city government that employed an average of five (5) or fewer police		
26		officers over the course of calendar year 2015 shall not be limited in the		
27		number of officers that they may hire under this section;

2			than one hundred (100) police officers over the course of calendar year 2015

6		(c)	A city government that employed an average of [more than ]one hundred
7			(100) <u>or more</u> police officers over the course of calendar year 2015 shall not

10			2015, whichever is greater.
