3 1979, at 17 years of age; and

6 138th Field Artillery Brigade and Garrison Training Command; and

8 served the United States of America honorably during several deployments,  
9 mobilizations, and operations, including Operation Desert Storm and Operation Iraqi  
10 Freedom; and

11 WHEREAS, William Keith Cox has been the recipient of numerous achievements  
12 and awards during his decades of service, including the Legion of Merit and the Ancient  
13 Order of St. Barbara;
