

1 A RESOLUTION adjourning the Senate in honor and loving memory of Randall G.  
2 Phillips.

3 WHEREAS, Randall G. Phillips was born in Taylor County on July 20, 1940, to the  
4 late Joseph F. Phillips and Maxine Gribbins Phillips; and

5 WHEREAS, Randall Phillips served his country in the Kentucky National Guard;  
6 and

7 WHEREAS, Randall Phillips graduated from the Bowling Green College of  
8 Commerce and was a long-standing member of Elk Horn Masonic Lodge #568 F&AM;

10 WHEREAS, Randall Phillips professed his faith in Christ and shared his life as a  
11 member of Campbellsville Baptist Church; and

12 WHEREAS, Randall Phillips retired after 29 years of service as Taylor County  
13 Court Clerk, having served under four governors. He also was the owner and operator of  
14 Southern Binding; and

15 WHEREAS, Randall Phillips loved golf, playing cards, and anything University of  
16 Kentucky, but he delighted in spoiling his grandchildren; and

17 WHEREAS, Randall Phillips departed this earthly life on February 9, 2020, leaving  
18 his family, his friends, and his community in solemn mourning; and

19 WHEREAS, Randall Phillips is survived by his wife of 55 years, Pat K. Phillips; his  
20 son, Kevin Phillips (Jamie); his daughter, Tracy Gibson (Chip); his four grandsons,  
21 Mason Phillips, Aidan Phillips, Jake Gibson, and Noah Gibson; his sister-in-law,  
22 Geraldine Phillips; his niece, Jolene Kearnes; his special friend and caregiver, Joanie  
23 Bright; and many other relatives and friends. He is preceded in death by his parents and  
24 his brother, Darrell Phillips;
