8 Conflict, he served as head of metal fabrication planning at the Naval Ordnance Station
9 for 33 years; and

10 WHEREAS, a lifelong University of Louisville fan, Jerry Blume was a past officer
11 and member of the Men's Club, and served as head football coach of Sts. Simon and Jude
12 Church from 1959-1961; and

13 WHEREAS, Jerry Blume, beloved husband, father, grandfather, brother, and
14 companion, departed this earthly life and entered into the kingdom of Heaven on
15 December 9, 2019, leaving his family, friends, and all those whose lives he touched in
16 solemn mourning; and

18 daughter, Linda Blume-Marr; and six siblings. He is survived by Mary Blume; children,
