19	artifacts. She turned her collection of postcards into a four-book series, and her collection
20	was recognized and displayed at the William J. Clinton Presidential Library and Museum
21	in Little Rock, Arkansas; and
22	WHEREAS, Rosetta Quisenberry, esteemed educator, master collector of African
23	American artifacts, and cherished wife, sister, and aunt, departed this earthly life and
24	entered into the kingdom of Heaven on February 10, 2020, leaving her family, friends,
