

1 A RESOLUTION confirming the reappointment of Craig C. Dilger to the Kentucky
2 Registry of Election Finance.

3 WHEREAS, in accordance with KRS 121.110, and by virtue of Executive Order
4 2019-1302, dated December 9, 2019, Governor Matthew G. Bevin has reappointed Craig
5 C. Dilger of Louisville, Kentucky, to the Kentucky Registry of Election Finance,
6 representing nonpartisan organizations, to serve for a term expiring August 15, 2020; and

7 WHEREAS, the reappointment is subject to Senate confirmation; and

8 WHEREAS, Craig C. Dilger has been determined to meet the requirements of KRS
9 121.110, being at least 25 years of age, a registered voter in the Commonwealth of
10 Kentucky, not an announced candidate for public office, and not an officer of a political
11 party's state central executive committee; not having been convicted of an election
12 offense; being a person of high ethical standards with an active interest in promoting fair
13 elections; having a record of civic involvement; and having previous experience as a
14 member of the Kentucky Registry of Election Finance;

15 NOW, THEREFORE,

16 ***Be it resolved by the Senate of the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of***
17 ***Kentucky:***

18 ➔Section 1. The Senate hereby confirms the reappointment of Craig C. Dilger to
19 the Kentucky Registry of Election Finance.

20 ➔Section 2. The Clerk of the Senate shall forward a copy of this Resolution and
