1	A RESOLUTION recognizing the 2020 Kentucky Census Quilt.
2	WHEREAS, the United States Constitution mandates that a census of the
3	population be conducted each decade and the United States Census Bureau is required by
4	law to conduct a count of the population; and
5	WHEREAS, billions of dollars in federal and state funding are allocated to
6	communities based, in part, on census data; and
7	WHEREAS, census data determine how many seats each state will have in the
8	United States House of Representatives and for redistricting of state legislatures, county
9	and city legislative bodies, and voting districts; and
10	WHEREAS, the United States Census Bureau encourages the promotion of
11	participation in the 2020 United States Census; and
12	WHEREAS, the Kentucky Department of Libraries and Archives is working with
13	the Kentucky Extension Homemakers Association (KEHA) and the United States Census
14	Bureau to promote the 2020 United States Census; and
15	WHEREAS, KEHA has worked with the United States Census Bureau to create a
16	unique quilt featuring one square from each of Kentucky's 120 counties; and
17	WHEREAS, in just four months, KEHA members from all over the Commonwealth
18	designed and created quilt squares representing each Kentucky county and these quilt
19	squares were bound together to make the 2020 Kentucky Census Quilt; and
20	WHEREAS, the 2020 Kentucky Census Quilt was unveiled at The National Quilt
21	Museum in Paducah, Kentucky, in September 2019 and will be on display at public
22	libraries in more than a dozen Kentucky counties; and
23	WHEREAS, the 2020 Kentucky Census Quilt demonstrates that each county
24	matters, and reminds Kentuckians that every person must be counted to ensure that
25	Kentucky has appropriate congressional representation and federal funding; and
26	WHEREAS, the 2020 Kentucky Census Quilt project is designed to encourage
27	every Kentuckian to complete and return his or her census questionnaire and ensure that
