5 WHEREAS, Joe Nevills, a resident of Georgetown, Kentucky, won in the 6 feature/commentary writing category for his piece "Biting the Dust: A Long Goodbye to 7 Mount Pleasant Meadows"; and

8 WHEREAS, "Biting the Dust" focuses on the demise of a small mixed-breed track 9 in Michigan, weaving the stories of a trainer, jockey, track announcer, and marketing 10 director and incorporating Mr. Nevills' own deep, personal history with thoroughbred 11 racing; and

WHEREAS, the Media Eclipse Award was a career-long dream for Joe Nevills, who called his piece "a John Mellencamp song about horse racing, without the music." The piece, which took Mr. Nevills five years to write, was as much a love song to a dying track as an investigation into the real, often unheralded individuals who make up the heart and soul of the thoroughbred racing industry; and

WHEREAS, this body rightfully honors a profoundly talented Kentucky writer onthis day who has achieved highest distinction in his field; and

WHEREAS, in so doing, the members grant Joe Nevills best wishes as he continues to write about the horse racing industry, thank him for his extraordinary contributions to journalism in this Commonwealth, and congratulate him upon winning a 2019 Media Eclipse Award;
