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1	A RESOLUTION supporting, educating, and promoting organ donors.
2	WHEREAS, it is rightful that this body honor those agencies that seek to educate
3	Kentuckians about organ, eye, and tissue donation, and tirelessly strive to push the
4	citizens of the Commonwealth into action to save lives; and
5	WHEREAS, there are 953 Kentuckians currently waiting on a lifesaving organ
6	transplant. Many more are in need of tissue and cornea transplants; and
7	WHEREAS, tragically, 22 people die each day waiting on a lifesaving organ
8	transplant; and
9	WHEREAS, currently 62 percent of Kentuckians are registered organ donors, and
10	to increase this number, public education about the issue is vital; and
11	WHEREAS, over 99 percent of those Kentuckians who are registered did so at their
12	local Circuit Court Clerk's Office; and
13	WHEREAS, in 2019, 415 organs were recovered and transplanted thanks to 135
14	generous organ donors. A groundbreaking 523 tissue donors healed more lives than ever,
15	and over 700 donors gave sight through cornea donation; and
16	WHEREAS, organ, tissue, and cornea donors and their families leave a lasting
17	legacy on earth through their miraculous gifts of life; and
18	WHEREAS, each year, the Aftercare Program supports thousands of donor families
19	with grief support and correspondence, including interactions between recipients and
20	donor families; and
21	WHEREAS, it is essential that Kentuckians learn about the importance of organ,
22	tissue, and cornea donation and become advocates for the importance of donation; and
23	WHEREAS, this body thanks the agencies whose efforts toward this cause have
24	been instrumental, such as UK HealthCare, Norton Children's, and UofL Health
25	transplant programs; Kentucky Organ Donor Affiliates and the LifeCenter Organ Donor
26	Network; the Kentucky Association of Circuit Court Clerks and Trust for Life; the
27	Kidney Health Alliance of Kentucky and the National Kidney Foundation; the Kentucky

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- Blood Center and Red Cross; the Kentucky Lions Eye Bank; and Donate Life
 ambassadors and volunteers;
