

1 A RESOLUTION adjourning the Senate in honor and loving memory of Jim Cox.

2 WHEREAS, Jim Cox was a son of this Commonwealth, having been born in
3 Catlettsburg on May 21, 1948; and

4 WHEREAS, Jim Cox attended the University of Kentucky before serving with the
5 Lexington Police Department for 28 years and retiring as a Lieutenant; and

6 WHEREAS, during his meritorious service with the Lexington Police Department,
7 Jim Cox worked with the DEA, the FBI, the Secret Service, the Central Kentucky Task
8 Force, and Kentucky Homeland Security, and as an investigator for the Office of the
9 Kentucky Attorney General; and

10 WHEREAS, Jim Cox, beloved law enforcement officer and cherished husband,
11 father, and grandfather, departed this earthly life on January 12, 2020, leaving all those
12 whose lives he touched in solemn mourning; and

13 WHEREAS, Jim Cox is survived by his wife of 48 years, Diane; children, Colleen,
14 Jimmy, and Jared; grandchildren, Alexandra, Quinn, Darcy, Finnegan, and Adelaide; and
15 a host of other family members, friends, and loved ones who will dearly miss his presence
16 in their lives;

18 ***Be it resolved by the Senate of the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of***
19 ***Kentucky:***

20 ➔Section 1. The members of the Senate hereby express their most profound
21 sympathy upon the passing of Jim Cox, and posthumously thank him for his service to
22 this Commonwealth's law enforcement community.

23 ➔Section 2. When the Senate adjourns this day, it does so in honor and loving
24 memory of Jim Cox.
