4 born in Sparksville on April 9, 1939, to the late Oattie and Maxine Harvey Wheeler; and

6 System who retired after 27 years of extraordinary service. A tireless and passionate
7 advocate for her students, especially those who were underprivileged, she dedicated
8 herself to her profession and to a generation of Adair County students who will forever be

13 granddaughter, departed this earthly life and entered into the kingdom of Heaven on

15 solemn mourning; and

16 WHEREAS, Ramona Barbee is survived by her daughters, Susan Barbee-Harvey
17 and her husband, Terry, and Sarah Espinosa and her husband, Victor; granddaughter,
18 Annelise Kate Espinosa; and a host of other family members, friends, and loved ones who
19 will dearly miss her presence in their lives;
