1	A RESOLUTION urging the General Assembly to adopt legislation to adequately

3	WHEREAS, the Commonwealth of Kentucky has the responsibility to provide safe,
4	efficient transportation systems to the citizens and businesses that call Kentucky home;
5	and
6	WHEREAS, the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet has the responsibility to maintain
7	and repair 27,620 miles of roadway, along with 14,300 bridges; and
8	WHEREAS, the Transportation Cabinet needs hundreds of millions of dollars
9	annually in new transportation funding to adequately improve and maintain Kentucky's
10	state transportation system; and
11	WHEREAS, county and city governments, which have the responsibility to
12	maintain their county and city transportation systems, also need additional funding to
13	improve and maintain their systems and have forged an agreement on a more equitable
14	distribution of motor fuel tax revenue; and
15	WHEREAS, other modes of transportation, such as aviation, public transit,
16	railroads, and riverports, have identified state funding needs that must be funded through
17	the General Fund; and
18	WHEREAS, since 2015, due to falling gas prices and reduced fuel tax revenues,
19	state transportation funding dropped nearly \$200 million per year; and
20	WHEREAS, the expiration of the Transportation Cabinet's ability to use federal toll
21	credits to match federal funding now requires the annual obligation of approximately
22	\$110 million in Road Fund dollars to access federal funding and further strains our ability
23	to effectively develop and maintain an effective and efficient transportation system; and
24	WHEREAS, legislative action is necessary to increase available funding for the
25	Transportation Cabinet, county and city governments, and the other transportation modes;
26	NOW, THEREFORE,
