- it will not do business with a manufacturer, retailer, or distributor of firearms, firearms accessories, or ammunition; a shooting range; or a trade association solely because the manufacturer, retailer, distributor, shooting range, or trade association supports or is engaged in the lawful commerce of firearms, firearms accessories, or ammunition products.
- (2) Nothing in Sections 1 to 3 of this Act shall be construed to prohibit, restrict, or in any way interfere with a financial institution or government entity making any decision to do business with any entity when that decision is based on business or financial considerations.
- →SECTION 3. A NEW SECTION OF KRS CHAPTER 237 IS CREATED TO READ AS FOLLOWS:

The Attorney General may file a civil cause of action in District Court in the name of the Commonwealth against a financial institution or government entity believed to be engaging in or that has previously engaged in an unlawful discriminatory practice under Section 2 of this
