On page 1, line 5, after the words "Sections 1 to" delete "4" and insert "3"; and

On page 2, beginning on line 5 through page 4, line 8, delete in its entirety and insert in lieu thereof:

"(1) It shall be unlawful for a financial institution or government entity to adopt a policy that it will not do business with a manufacturer, retailer, or distributor of firearms, firearms accessories, or ammunition; a shooting range; or a trade association solely because the manufacturer, retailer, distributor, shooting range, or trade association supports or is engaged in the lawful commerce of firearms, firearms accessories, or ammunition products.

(2) Nothing in Sections 1 to 3 of this Act shall be construed to prohibit, restrict, or in any way interfere with a financial institution or government entity making any decision to do business with any entity when that decision is based on business or financial considerations.

➔SECTION 3. A NEW SECTION OF KRS CHAPTER 237 IS CREATED TO READ AS FOLLOWS:

The Attorney General may file a civil cause of action in District Court in the name of the Commonwealth against a financial institution or government entity believed to be engaging in or that has previously engaged in an unlawful discriminatory practice under Section 2 of this

Act to:

- (1) Obtain a declaratory judgment that the act or practice violates Section 2 of this Act;**
- (2) Enjoin any act or practice that violates Section 2 of this Act by seeking a temporary restraining order or preliminary or permanent injunction, without bond, upon the giving of appropriate notice; or**
- (3) Recover civil penalties of up to ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) per violation of Section 2 of this Act."**
