Beginning on page 18, line 23, and continuing to page 19, line 1, by deleting paragraph (l) in its entirety and inserting the following in lieu thereof:

"(1) Any person who is retired for service from the retirement system and is reemployed by an employer identified in this subsection in a position that the board of trustees deems to be a member, except that any person who <u>becomes a member[retires]</u> on or after January 1, <u>2022[2019]</u>, <u>and subsequently draws a monthly lifetime retirement</u> <u>allowance</u>, shall upon reemployment after retirement not earn a second retirement account;"; and

On page 94, beginning on line 16 and continuing to line 27 by deleting subsection (10)(a) in its entirety and inserting the following in lieu thereof:

"(10) (a) Notwithstanding the provisions of this section, individuals who <u>become members on</u>

<u>or after January 1, 2022, who subsequently</u> retire and begin drawing a <u>monthly</u>

<u>lifetime</u> retirement allowance from [one (1) or more of the systems or plans administered by the Kentucky Retirement Systems,]the Teachers' Retirement System on or after January 1, 2019], who <u>following retirement</u> are reemployed [on or after January 1, 2019,]with an employer participating in the Teachers' Retirement System, shall not be eligible to contribute to or earn benefits in a second retirement account *in the Teachers' Retirement System*
