On page 17, delete lines 1 to 27 in their entirety and insert in lieu thereof:

"(3) Requests for records or other documents in the custody of the Legislative Research Commission or the General Assembly shall be directed to the director of the Legislative Research Commission, who shall determine within five (5) days, excepting Saturdays, Sundays, and legal holidays, after the receipt of the request whether to comply with the request, and shall, in writing notify the person making the request of his or her decision. Except for KRS 61.880(3), subsection (5) of Section 5 of this Act, and 61.882, provisions of the Open Records Act, KRS 61.870 to 61.884, shall apply to a request for inspection or copies of documents or other items not set forth in subsection (2) of this section, and except that a request for review[ under KRS 61.880] of any determination by the director regarding a request for records set forth in this section shall be made to the Legislative Research Commission, which shall issue its decision within thirty (30) days of the first scheduled meeting held following receipt for review. [ If the Legislative Research Commission, which shall issue its decision on a review of the director's determination within thirty (30) days does not issue its decision on a review of the director's determination within thirty (30) days of submission to if of the matter, the director's determination may be appealed to the Franklin Circuit Court within sixty (60) days of its issuance.] For purposes of this subsection, any reference to the Attorney General in KRS 61.880[ and 61.882] shall

On page 18, delete lines 1 to 22 in their entirety and insert in lieu thereof:

- "(4) (a) If a public agency other than the Legislative Research Commission receives a request for inspection of a public record that may fall under this section, the official custodian of the records for the public agency shall notify the director of the Legislative Research Commission within two (2) days of receipt of the request.

  The official custodian of records for the public agency that received the request shall be required to respond to the request.
  - (b) If the Legislative Research Commission receives a request relating to a specific member of the General Assembly, the director shall notify that member within one

    (1) day of receipt of the request.
- (5) Nothing in this section shall be construed as a waiver or diminishment of any constitutional, common law, or statutory defenses, privileges, or immunities that may apply to any member of the General Assembly, legislative staff, legislative agency or entity, or any other member or employee of the legislative branch."
