| 3 | Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky: |
| 4 | → SECTION 1. A NEW SECTION OF KRS CHAPTER 7 IS CREATED TO |
| 5 | READ AS FOLLOWS: |
| 6 | (1) The Commission on Race and Access to Opportunity is hereby established within |
| 7 | the legislative department of state government. The purpose of the commission |
| 8 | shall be to conduct studies and research on issues where disparities may exist |
| 9 | across the sectors of educational equity, child welfare, health, economic |
| 10 | opportunity, juvenile justice, criminal justice, and any other sectors that are |
| 11 | deemed relevant in an effort to identify areas of improvement in providing |
| 12 | services and opportunities for minority communities. |
| 13 | (2) The commission shall be composed of the following thirteen (13) members: |
| 14 | (a) The Attorney General or his or her designee; |
| 15 | (b) Four (4) members of the Senate, two (2) of whom shall be appointed by the |
| 16 | Senate President, and two (2) of whom shall be appointed by the Senate |
| 17 | Minority Floor Leader; |
| 18 | (c) Four (4) members of the House of Representatives, two (2) of whom shall |
| 19 | be appointed by the Speaker of the House, and two (2) of whom shall be |
| 20 | appointed by the House Minority Floor Leader; and |
| 21 | (d) Four (4) members from the private and nonprofit sectors, universities, or |
| 22 | local governments who have expertise in social policy related to education, |
| 23 | health, economic development, or the law and who shall be appointed for up |
| 24 | to two (2) consecutive, three (3) year terms by the following: |
| 25 | 1. One (1) shall be appointed by the Senate President; |
| 26 | 2. One (1) shall be appointed by the Senate Minority Floor Leader; |
| 27 | 3. One (1) shall be appointed by the Speaker of the House: and |

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| 1 | | 4. One (1) shall be appointed by the House Minority Floor Leader. |
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| 2 | <u>(3)</u> | The President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House shall each appoint one |
| 3 | | (1) co-chair of the commission from among that chamber's members appointed |
| 4 | | to the commission. |
| 5 | <u>(4)</u> | Any vacancy which may occur in the membership of the commission shall be |
| 6 | | filled by the appointing authority who made the original appointment. |
| 7 | <u>(5)</u> | The commission shall have the authority to: |
| 8 | | (a) Hold monthly meetings during the interim meeting period of the General |
| 9 | | Assembly; |
| 10 | | (b) Seek comment, testimony, documents, records, or other information from |
| 11 | | various government agencies and organizations representing the public to |
| 12 | | address existing and potential barriers to minority success and |
| 13 | | empowerment; and |
| 14 | | (c) Provide research driven policy proposals and actionable items when areas |
| 15 | | of improvement are identified. |
| 16 | <u>(6)</u> | A majority of the entire membership of the commission shall constitute a |
| 17 | | quorum. |
| 18 | <u>(7)</u> | The Legislative Research Commission shall have exclusive jurisdiction over the |
| 19 | | employment of personnel necessary to carry out the provisions of this section. |
| 20 | <u>(8)</u> | The commission shall publish and submit an annual report to the Legislative |
| 21 | | Research Commission with recommendations on any potential legislative or |
| 22 | | administrative actions with respect to their findings. |

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
