1	AN ACT relating to probation and parole.
2	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:
3	→ SECTION 1. A NEW SECTION OF KRS 439.250 TO 439.560 IS CREATED
4	TO READ AS FOLLOWS:
5	(1) A probation and parole officer who supervises a probationer or parolee shall
6	schedule meetings, which are required as a condition of the individual's
7	probation or parole, at such times and locations that accommodate the work
8	schedule of the probationer or parolee if he or she is employed by another person
9	or entity.
10	(2) Except as provided in KRS 17.170, to comply with subsection (1) of this section,
11	in lieu of requiring the probationer or parolee to report in-person for the meeting,
12	the probation and parole officer may utilize authorized technology, including a
13	cellular telephone and other electronic communication devices, that allows
14	simultaneous voice and video communication in real time between the
15	probationer or parolee and the probation and parole officer. Authorized
16	technology may also be used for meetings with a probationer or parolee who is
17	self-employed at the discretion of the probationer's or parolee's probation and
18	parole officer and in accordance with any administrative regulation promulgated
19	by the department pursuant to this section.
20	(3) The department shall promulgate administrative regulations to implement this
21	section, which shall include the following:
22	(a) Minimum standards and guidelines for authorized technology;
23	(b) How authorized technology may be used; and
24	(c) Standards for determining the eligibility and suitability of a probationer or
25	parolee to meet his or her reporting requirement through the use of
26	authorized technology. The eligibility and suitability standards shall include
27	consideration of the severity of the probationer's or parolee's underlying

1criminal conviction, criminal history, supervision level, and past2supervision history.
