3	→SECTION 1. A NEW SECTION OF KRS CHAPTER 341 IS CREATED TO

5	(1) Upon request of the alleged overpayment recipient, the secretary may waive an
6	overpayment of benefits if he or she finds:
7	(a) The overpayment was made without fault on the part of the recipient;
8	(b) The overpayment was not the result of fraud, misrepresentation, or willful
9	nondisclosure of the recipient; and
10	(c) Recovery would be contrary to equity and good conscience.
11	(2) (a) Requests for waiver of overpayment of benefits under subsection (1) of this
12	section shall be made within thirty (30) days after the date the secretary
13	mails to the alleged overpayment recipient the notification of the
14	overpayment determination via first-class United States mail.
15	(b) Notice of the secretary's determination shall include information explaining
16	how the alleged overpayment recipient may request a waiver of overpayment
17	and explain how the alleged overpayment recipient may appeal the
18	secretary's final determination.
19	(3) The secretary shall make waiver determinations as follows:
20	(a) The secretary shall appoint one (1) or more impartial referees according to
21	KRS 341.125 to hear and decide waiver appeals;
22	(b) A party to a waiver determination may file an appeal to a referee as to any
23	matter therein within thirty (30) days after the date such determination was
24	mailed to his or her last known address in accordance with subsection (2)(a)
25	of this section;
26	(c) If a waiver is allowed by a determination of the secretary or a decision of a
27	referee, the commission, the secretary, or a reviewing court, the waiver shall
