1	A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION supporting civic education and declaring the
2	third week in September as the kick-off week for America's Legislators Back to School
3	Program, and encouraging participation in the "Principal for a Day" program.
4	WHEREAS, the Commonwealth of Kentucky was created as a representative
5	democracy in which all governmental power is inherent in the people who exercise that
6	power through the legislative, executive, and judicial branches; and
7	WHEREAS, in recent years, citizen interest in government and knowledge of the
8	political system has declined in part due to a weakening belief in and a lack of
9	understanding of the virtues and knowledge needed for a successful republican form of
10	government; and
11	WHEREAS, Benjamin Rush, signer of the Declaration of Independence stated,
12	"There is but one method of rendering a republican form of government durable, and that
13	is by disseminating the seeds of virtue and knowledge through every part of the state by
14	means of proper places and modes of education and this can be done effectively only by
15	the aid of the legislature"; and
16	WHEREAS, the National Conference of State Legislatures (NCSL) has passed a
17	resolution that says that the operations of the state legislatures and the roles of individual
18	legislators are often little understood by citizens and that public understanding of the
19	institutions and processes of the government is critical to building public trust and
20	confidence; and
21	WHEREAS, the NCSL resolution also states that state legislatures need to bring
22	about better understanding of the concept of representative democracy and that education
23	about representative democracy should emphasize the importance of compromise and the
24	difficulty of resolving competing interests in a diverse society; and
25	WHEREAS, civic education is a vital tool to promote greater understanding of the
26	legislative institution and the role of legislators in representative democracy and is
27	required for graduation from high school in Kentucky; and

1	WHEREAS, the NCSL urges the nation's state legislatures to promote civic
2	education about representative democracy; and
3	WHEREAS, it is equally important for legislators to understand the impact of their
4	policy and funding decisions on the daily operation of schools and upon school leaders,
5	teachers and students; and
6	WHEREAS, the NCSL has established America's Legislators Back to School
7	Program, a national program where state legislators across the nation visit schools and
8	classrooms to talk about the legislature and to observe activities in the schools; and
9	WHEREAS, the Kentucky Association of School Administrators (KASA) has
10	established a "Principal for a Day" program that encourages legislators to spend a portion
11	of a school day shadowing a school principal in order to observe first-hand the role of a
12	school leader and the work of teachers and students; and
13	WHEREAS, all legislators will benefit from interacting with students, teachers, and
14	administrators and witnessing their daily commitment to improving Kentucky's schools;
15	NOW, THEREFORE,
16	Be it resolved by the House of Representatives of the General Assembly of the
17	Commonwealth of Kentucky, the Senate concurring therein:
18	→ Section 1. The General Assembly supports civic education to promote greater
19	understanding of the legislative institution and the role of legislators in representative
20	democracy.
21	→ Section 2. The General Assembly declares that the third week in September
22	shall be designated as the kick-off week for Kentucky's Legislators Back to School
23	Program and urges all members of the legislature to visit schools during that week and
24	throughout the school year.
25	→ Section 3. The General Assembly encourages all members of the legislature to
26	spend some portion of these school visits shadowing the school principal as part of the
27	"Principal for a Day" program.
