

1 A RESOLUTION recognizing May 2021 as National Beef Month in Kentucky.

2 WHEREAS, beef is the second most popular meat in the United States, as  
3 Americans eat an average of roughly 57 pounds of beef each year; and

4 WHEREAS, beef production is a multibillion dollar industry in the United States,  
5 as America produces an estimated 27 billion pounds of beef each year, which represents  
6 nearly 20 percent of the world's beef; and

7 WHEREAS, cattle production is important to the economy of the Commonwealth,  
8 as Kentucky is home to more than 2 million cattle and calves, and is the largest beef cattle  
9 state east of the Mississippi River; and

10 WHEREAS, Kentucky is home to approximately 38,000 farms that produce beef  
11 cattle; and

12 WHEREAS, Kentucky beef cattle sales, including calves, totaled nearly \$700  
13 million in 2019; and

14 WHEREAS, leaders of the Kentucky Cattlemen's Association and the Kentucky  
15 Beef Council work diligently on behalf of beef producers across the Commonwealth to  
16 promote beef consumption, serve as a resource for information to further educate  
17 producers, and develop programs that help farmers produce more beef and increase  
18 profitability; and

19 WHEREAS, beef is a great source of ten essential nutrients that support a heart-  
20 healthy lifestyle, including protein, zinc, iron, and B vitamins, which provide our bodies  
21 with the strength to thrive and grow throughout all stages of life; and

22 WHEREAS, high-quality, natural, fresh ground beef that is entirely raised,  
23 processed, and packaged in Kentucky, packaged with the label of Kentucky Cattlemen's  
24 Ground Beef, is now available at select Kroger stores across the Commonwealth,  
25 southern Indiana, and Tennessee;

26 NOW, THEREFORE,

27 ***Be it resolved by the House of Representatives of the General Assembly of the***

2       ➔Section 1. The House of Representatives does hereby recognize the month of  
3 May 2021 as National Beef Month and commends all those cattle farmers, ranchers, and  
4 all other agribusiness members involved in beef production across the Commonwealth.
