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A RESOLUTION recognizing April 2021 as National Soybean Month in Kentucky.

- 2 WHEREAS, known as the "miracle bean," soybeans have long been regarded as the
  3 most versatile agricultural commodity in the world; and
- WHEREAS, soybean production is a multibillion-dollar industry in the United
  States, as an estimated 84 million acres of farmland were devoted to growing soybeans in
  2020. The United States currently ranks as the leading country in worldwide soybean
  production; and

8 WHEREAS, soybeans and components of soybeans, soybean oil, and soybean meal, 9 are used in a wide variety of applications, including feed for the state's leading 10 agricultural commodity, poultry, as well as livestock feed, ingredients in multiple food 11 products found on store shelves, biodiesel fuel, industrial applications, and many other 12 uses; and

WHEREAS, farmers in Kentucky planted approximately 1.8 million acres of
soybeans in 2020 that yielded roughly 101 million bushels; and

WHEREAS, the soybean crop has an economic impact in the Commonwealth of
well over \$1 billion, which generates income for farm families and related agribusinesses;
and

WHEREAS, the soybean crop is a significant export commodity for the United States in a variety of forms: whole beans, soybean meal, soybean oil, and as value-added exports for international markets that rely on the United States to supply high-quality poultry, pork, and beef; and

WHEREAS, farmer-leaders of the Kentucky Soybean Association and the Kentucky Soybean Promotion Board work diligently on behalf of soybean farmers across the Commonwealth to invest in research and programs that help them to produce more soybeans and increase profitability, and promote the use of soybeans and soy products in a variety of applications;
