

1 A RESOLUTION congratulating Joe Biden on his presidential election.

2 WHEREAS, in the midst of a pandemic, the Commonwealth of Kentucky instituted
3 novel forms of voter participation; and

4 WHEREAS, with bipartisan action by the Governor and Secretary of State, the
5 Commonwealth of Kentucky had near record voter turnout; and

6 WHEREAS, after the election, Attorney General Daniel Cameron and Secretary of
7 State Michael Adams announced that there were no indications of widespread voter fraud
8 in Kentucky; and

9 WHEREAS, Attorney General William Barr further stated that there was no
10 widespread voter fraud in the United States; and

11 WHEREAS, Joe Biden was lawfully elected President of the United States;

12 NOW, THEREFORE,

13 *Be it resolved by the House of Representatives of the General Assembly of the*
14 *Commonwealth of Kentucky:*

15 ➔Section 1. The House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Kentucky
16 congratulates Joe Biden on his election as President of the United States.
