1		AN ACT relating to the creation of a Commission on Race and Access to
2	Opp	ortunity.
3	Be it	t enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:
4		→ SECTION 1. A NEW SECTION OF KRS CHAPTER 7 IS CREATED TO
5	REA	AD AS FOLLOWS:
6	<u>(1)</u>	The Commission on Race and Access to Opportunity is hereby established within
7		the legislative department of state government. The purpose of the commission
8		shall be to conduct studies and research on issues where disparities may exist
9		across the sectors of educational equity, health, economic opportunity, and
10		criminal justice in an effort to identify areas of improvement in providing services
11		and opportunities for minority communities.
12	<u>(2)</u>	The commission shall be composed of the following thirteen (13) members:
13		(a) The executive director of the Kentucky Human Rights Commission or his or
14		<u>her designee;</u>
15		(b) Four (4) members of the Senate, two (2) of whom shall be appointed by the
16		Senate President, and two (2) of whom shall be appointed by the Senate
17		Minority Floor Leader;
18		(c) Four (4) member of the House of Representatives, two (2) of whom shall be
19		appointed by the Speaker of the House, and two (2) of whom shall be
20		appointed by the House Minority Floor Leader; and
21		(d) Four (4) members who are not affiliated with state government who have
22		expertise in education, health, economic development, or the law and who
23		shall be appointed for up to two (2) consecutive, three (3) year terms by the
24		following:
25		1. One (1) shall be appointed by the Senate President;
26		2. One (1) shall be appointed by the Senate Minority Floor Leader;
27		3. One (1) shall be appointed by the Speaker of the House; and

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1		4. One (1) shall be appointed by the House Minority Floor Leader.
2	<u>(3)</u>	The President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House shall each appoint one
3		(1) co-chair of the commission from among that chamber's members appointed
4		to the commission.
5	<u>(4)</u>	Any vacancy which may occur in the membership of the commission shall be
6		filled by the appointing authority who made the original appointment.
7	<u>(5)</u>	The commission shall have the authority to:
8		1. Hold monthly meetings during the interim meeting period of the General
9		Assembly;
10		2. Seek comment, testimony, documents, records, or other information from
11		various government agencies and organizations representing the public to
12		address existing barriers to minority success and empowerment; and
13		3. Provide research driven policy proposals and actionable items when areas
14		of improvement are identified.
15	<u>(6)</u>	A majority of the entire membership of the commission shall constitute a
16		quorum.
17	<u>(7)</u>	The Legislative Research Commission shall have exclusive jurisdiction over the
18		employment of personnel necessary to carry out the provisions of this section.
19	<u>(8)</u>	The commission shall publish an annual report with recommendations on any
20		potential legislative or administrative actions with respect to their findings.
