1 AN ACT relating to economic development.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:

- 3 → Section 1. KRS 154.10-020 is amended to read as follows:
- 4 (1) The Governor shall be the chairman of the board and upon his <u>or her</u> absence the
- 5 secretary of the Governor's Executive Cabinet shall serve as chairman.
- 6 (2) The board shall elect from among the private sector members a vice chairman of the
- board. The initial term of office for the vice chairman shall expire December 31,
- 8 1994, and the subsequent terms of office of the vice chairman shall be for a period
- 9 of two (2) years.

- 10 (3) Upon the absence of both the Governor and the secretary of the Governor's
- Executive Cabinet, the vice chairman shall serve as chairman.
- 12 (4) The board may establish an executive committee consisting of the chairman, the
- vice chairman, the secretary of the cabinet, and not more than three (3) additional
- board members selected jointly by the chairman and vice chairman. The executive
- 15 committee shall have such authority as the board delegates to it, except that the
- board shall not delegate to the executive committee the authority to take actions
- 17 requiring approval by a majority of the entire board under KRS 154.10-010(10).
- 18 (5) The secretary and other officers and employees of the cabinet shall not be required
- 19 to disclose confidential information concerning existing businesses or business
- 20 prospects with which the board or cabinet is dealing, including the identity of the
- businesses, to members of the board other than the executive committee. The
- 22 executive committee shall provide advice and assistance to the secretary in
- 23 negotiations with existing and prospective businesses. In the event the cabinet
- enters into an agreement with a business entity which requires approval by the
- General Assembly, the agreement shall be presented by the secretary to the board,
- 26 which shall make a recommendation of approval or disapproval of the agreement to
- the General Assembly.
