1	A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION directing the Legislative Research Commission
2	to study the impact of administrative regulations on the Commonwealth of Kentucky.
3	WHEREAS, administrative regulations are essential in ensuring that the executive
4	branch can carry out its constitutional duties; and
5	WHEREAS, administrative regulations are sometimes necessary to carry out the
6	goals of important legislation; and
7	WHEREAS, limits on administrative authority are imperative in ensuring that a
8	government does not encroach on the liberties of its people; and
9	WHEREAS, to ensure that a government agency does not overstep its authority,
10	clear authorizing language precisely defining the boundaries of executive authority is
11	essential to a healthy, functioning government; and
12	WHEREAS, statutes that do not clearly define parameters of executive authority in
13	administrative regulation can lead to confusion and an inadvertent abuse of power; and
14	WHEREAS, administrative regulations that are unclear can lead to confusion and
15	noncompliance on the part of the citizen; and
16	WHEREAS, administrative regulations that overstep their boundaries lead to lack
17	of confidence in the rule of law;
18	NOW, THEREFORE,
19	Be it resolved by the Senate of the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of
20	Kentucky, the House of Representatives concurring therein:
21	→ Section 1. The staff of the Legislative Research Commission is directed to
22	complete a study of the effectiveness of administrative regulations in the Commonwealth
23	of Kentucky.
24	→ Section 2. The study under Section 1 of this Resolution shall include an analysis
25	of:
26	(1) Whether statutes authorizing the promulgation of administrative regulations

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are clear;

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(2) Whether any statutes authorizing administrative regulations are unclear, and what changes would be needed to provide more clarity;

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- 3 (3) Whether administrative regulations are clear and conform to their authorizing 4 statutes;
- Whether any administrative regulations are unclear or do not conform to statutory authority, and what changes need to be made to provide clarity to unclear regulations or ensure nonconforming regulations are in compliance; and
- 8 (5) The estimated cost of unclear statutes and administrative regulations and 9 nonconforming regulations to the Commonwealth.
 - → Section 3. The study described in Sections 1 and 2 of this Resolution shall be submitted to the Interim Joint Committee on State Government and the Interim Joint Committee on Appropriations and Revenue no later than December 1, 2021.
- Section 4. Provisions of this Resolution to the contrary notwithstanding, the
 Legislative Research Commission shall have the authority to alternatively assign the
 issues identified herein to an interim joint committee or subcommittee thereof, and to
 designate a study completion date.
