11 she served in the music ministry and as a part of Revive; and

12 WHEREAS, Connie Jo Salyers, devout woman of God; esteemed educator; and

14 the kingdom of Heaven on August 6, 2020, leaving all those whose lives she touched in
15 solemn mourning; and

16 WHEREAS, Connie Jo Salyers was preceded in death by her parents; husband of 50
17 years, John Salyers; and son-in-law, Jeremy Lewis. She is survived by her daughters, Beth
18 Barker and her husband, Don, and Meredith Lewis; sister, Becky Danks and her husband,
