

1 A RESOLUTION adjourning the Senate in honor and loving memory of Roy  
2 Gordon Scott.

3 WHEREAS, Roy Gordon Scott was a son of this Commonwealth, having been born  
4 in Mercer County on October 10, 1954, to the late Roy Gordon and Annelle Scott; and

5 WHEREAS, Gordon Scott was a retired hazardous materials inspector for the  
6 Kentucky State Fire Marshal; and

7 WHEREAS, an active member of the National Rifle Association, Gordon Scott  
8 proudly served in the Kentucky National Guard for several years; and

9 WHEREAS, Gordon Scott was a member of the Harrodsburg Baptist Church; and

10 WHEREAS, Gordon Scott, American patriot and beloved husband, brother, and  
11 "Uncle DoDo," departed this earthly life and entered into the kingdom of Heaven on  
12 February 7, 2021, leaving all those whose lives he touched in solemn mourning; and

13 WHEREAS, Gordon Scott is survived by his wife, Kathy Cinnamon Scott; sister,  
14 Patricia (Eddie) Mayes; and his cherished nephews;

16 *Be it resolved by the Senate of the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of*  
17 *Kentucky:*

18 ➔Section 1. The Senate hereby expresses its most profound sympathy upon the  
19 passing of Roy Gordon Scott, and posthumously thanks him for his service in the  
20 Kentucky National Guard.
