

1 A RESOLUTION adjourning the Senate in honor and loving memory of Dr. Gerald
2 T. Slatin.

3 WHEREAS, Dr. Gerald Slatin was born in Indianapolis on December 9, 1933; and

4 WHEREAS, Dr. Slatin was a proud graduate of Indiana University. He joined the
5 United States Navy in 1957 and went on to teach at UCLA before joining the faculty at
6 the University of Kentucky; and

7 WHEREAS, Dr. Slatin taught sociology at UK for 27 years, and also served as the
8 department's Director of Graduate Studies; and

9 WHEREAS, Dr. Slatin was a passionate fan of jazz music who enjoyed cooking,
10 playing the piano, and reading; and

11 WHEREAS, Dr. Gerald Slatin, esteemed educator and beloved husband, father, and
12 grandfather, departed this earthly life on February 9, 2021, leaving all those whose lives
13 he touched in solemn mourning; and

14 WHEREAS, Dr. Slatin is survived by his beloved wife, Shirley Trinkle Slatin; son,
15 Todd Slatin and his wife, Amy; daughters, Lisa Slatin and Shelly Hancock and her
16 husband, Chad; grandchildren, Catarine and Harrison; and sister-in-law, GeorgeAnne
