1	A RESOLUTION recognizing the Commonwealth Policy Development Coalition.
2	WHEREAS, in Kentucky's universities and technical colleges, including the
3	University of Louisville with students across the Commonwealth, many students have
4	interest in policy work and a desire to bring positive change to the Commonwealth; and
5	WHEREAS, these young professional students often have a background with a
6	unique degree of experience with relevant legislative skills from prior experience, which
7	in some cases can lead students to attend schools outside the Commonwealth. This
8	background includes involvements such as internships with the Legislative Research
9	Commission, research involvements as seen at Posters at the Capitol, and participation in
10	the Kentucky Youth Assembly for up to seven years as hosted by the General Assembly,
11	which is the largest youth-in-government conference in the United States; and
12	WHEREAS, students have also gained public relations and strong community
13	leadership skills from groups like FBLA, 4H, FFA, youth conservation boards, local
14	volunteering experiences, and advocacy work; and
15	WHEREAS, the University of Louisville is a Carnegie-ranked research institution
16	designated as a premier metropolitan establishment for research and innovation, where it
17	and other university institutions in the Commonwealth have had research focuses relevant
18	to the entire Commonwealth of Kentucky. At the university, research often involves these
19	youth professional students who attend from the mountains and coal fields of eastern
20	Kentucky, to the hills of the Knobs, to the rolling land of central Kentucky, to the Jackson
21	Purchase along the Mississippi; and
22	WHEREAS, the Commonwealth Policy Development Coalition was founded as a
23	nonprofit think tank at the University of Louisville sponsored by faculty and run by
24	students from the undergraduate and pre-professional level, with training in policy
25	development and legislative ethics; and
26	WHEREAS, these students conduct policy work as Fellows advised by expert
27	university researchers to translate local research into policy proposals to issues faced by

the Commonwealth, and are conducting such work in vetting partnership with Kentucky

- 2 industry, interests, and members of the General Assembly from both parties; and
