

1 A RESOLUTION adjourning the Senate in honor and loving memory of Corey
2 Tomas Fannin.

3 WHEREAS, Corey Tomas Fannin was a son of this Commonwealth, having been
4 born in Lexington on September 15, 1980, to Dr. Bill and Debra Fannin; and

5 WHEREAS, Corey Fannin was raised in Pikeville and graduated as the
6 valedictorian of Pikeville High School in 1999; and

7 WHEREAS, Corey Fannin went on to the University of Kentucky and was sworn in
8 as an attorney in 2007. Known as a skilled and fair trial lawyer, he was a founding
9 member of the Circeo Fannin Law Firm in Lexington and had served as treasurer of the
10 Kentucky Justice Association; and

11 WHEREAS, a kind, compassionate man who married his "best friend," Liz, greeted
12 everyone with a warm smile and deep laugh, enjoyed hiking, fly fishing, and watching his
13 sons' ball games, Corey Fannin departed this earthly life on December 25, 2020, and this
14 body stands on this day in solemn reverence of all he accomplished and the many lives he
15 impacted; and

16 WHEREAS, preceded in death by his brother, Sean Michael Fannin, Corey Fannin
17 is survived by his wife, Elizabeth; sons, Henry and Owen; grandmother, Lois Belcher;
18 nieces, McKenzie Fannin and Aaliyah McAnellen; and his nieces' mother, Amy Ratliff;

24 the justice system in this Commonwealth.
